Credentialing Examination Pass Rate

- **Five-year average credentialing examination (American Registry of Radiologic Technologists Radiography exam) pass rate of not less than 75 percent at first attempt within six months of graduation.**

- Alumni survey If no response: Phone interview, Email, and/or Facebook communication with alumni
- The JRCERT has defined “not actively seeking employment “as: 1) graduate fails to communicate with program officials regarding employment status after multiple attempts, 2) graduate is unwilling to seek employment that requires relocation, 3) graduate is unwilling to accept employment due to salary or hours, 4) graduate is on active military duty, and/or 5) graduate is continuing education. If any graduate is not actively seeking employment in the profession, the individual should not be included in the calculation of job placement rate. Programs are reminded that graduates hired in part-time or per diem positions should be counted as employed.

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Program Completion Rate

- This is an annual benchmark established by the program. The program determines the entry point (e.g., required orientation date, final drop/add date, final date to drop with 100% tuition refund, official class roster date, etc.) used in calculating the program's completion rate. Consider only those students who completed the program during the reporting period, January 1, 2011-December 31, 2015
